



# How to Register for Major Courses

(Guidelines for Selecting Sections of Major Courses)

1. Please select the courses from the major you wish to apply for (AI Big Data, IT Convergence Business, TESOL).

2. Is the major you wish to apply for AI Big Data?

**YES** -> Unfortunately, due to university regulations, the course could not be offered because the number of applicants for this major was less than 10. But don't worry! If you enroll in the IT Convergence Business major, you can take the similar course [Introduction to Artificial Intelligence]. Please register for the courses under the IT Convergence Business major.

3. Are you an applicant for admission in March 2025? Yes vs. No

**Yes** -> The available sections for you are **Sections 44, 45, and 46**. However, TESOL majors can only choose **Section 44**.

You cannot select Sections 47, 48, or 49, as they will be assigned to new students entering in September.

**No** -> The available sections for you are Sections 47, 48, and 49. (Only for students entering in September 2025)

The English Grammar course is available in Sections 45, 46, and 47 (Only for students entering in September 2025).

**4. Are you a student admitted in March 2025? Has your major been confirmed for this semester?**

No. You are currently in the preliminary stage, and your major will be confirmed in December 2025 (tentatively).

Starting this semester, you can gain experience in your major and make your final decision.

**5. Is there an effective way to register for major courses?**

**Yes**, there is. By selecting **the same section number (44, 45, 46)** for other courses, you can avoid conflicts. For **example**, if you choose [Introduction to Artificial Intelligence, Section 46], it will be helpful to select Section 46 for the other two courses as well.

All courses have a capacity of 30 students, and once the quota is full, you will need to select a different section.

We would appreciate it if you could follow the same section number when registering for courses.
